## Fact Sheet

### **Overview**

Red Hawk Casino is owned by the Shingle Springs Tribal Gaming Authority, an instrumentality of the Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians. It is located 10 minutes east of Folsom, off the Red Hawk Parkway exit on Highway 50. Red Hawk Casino is managed by Lakes Entertainment, Inc. and blends a full complement of gaming excitement with the natural beauty of Northern California. The facility is 278,000 square feet, including 88,000 square feet of gaming space.

### **Gaming**

- Approximately 2,100 slot machines

- Slots and table games on the non-smoking lower level

## Gaming Fact Sheet

The 278,000 square foot Red Hawk Casino features 88,000 square feet of gaming space, including approximately 2,100 slot machines and 75 table games. Players must be 21 years of age to gamble.

- **Table games:** Red Hawk Casino offers Single Deck Blackjack, Double Deck Blackjack, Six Deck Shoe Blackjack, Fortune Pai Gow, Mystery Card Roulette, Three-Card Poker, Four-Card Poker, World Poker Tour® All-In Hold 'Em, Let It Ride, EZ Baccarat and Midi Baccarat. Red Hawk Casino is also the only casino in the region to feature Blackjack Switch, a proprietary game which allows players to play two hands simultaneously with identical wagers. Players have the option to keep their hands as they were dealt or switch the second card between hands, potentially allowing for a more favorable outcome. Table games are located throughout the main casino floor, the High-Limit area and the lower, non-smoking level. New games will be arriving soon.
- **Slot machines:** Players at Red Hawk Casino can also experience state-of-the-art games including Zeus 2™, Platinum Quick Hits™, Super Times Pay Poker™, Monopoly®, Powerball™, FA FA FA Fortune King™, Fort Knox™, Cashman Tonight™, Wheel of Fortune®, Indiana Jones™, Bank Buster™, Wheel Poker®, Millionizer®, and The Wizard of Oz™. Red Hawk Casino is also part of the 16-state Native American progressive gaming network, which offers some of the highest jackpots in the region. Multi-denominational slot machines are located throughout the main casino floor and the smoke-free lower level.
- **High Limit:** Also on the main casino level is Red Hawk's exclusive High-Limit area with slot denominations up to \$1,000 and table games with limits up to \$10,000. The High Limit area is also home to Wheel of Fortune®, Quick Hits™, Cleopatra®, Double Diamond® progressives and Blazing 7s®. This opulent room not only contains the latest in thrilling gaming action, but also boasts a lavish lounge and exclusive bar suited to the discriminating tastes of premier gamblers.
- **Red Hawk Rewards Club:** Red Hawk Rewards Club is the ultimate player loyalty program, which offers players the ability to earn points redeemable for a variety of exciting offers. Enrollment is free and player cards are available at any Club in the casino. The Red Hawk Rewards Club offers members the opportunity to earn points every time they play slot machines. To accommodate all levels of play, the Club offers Gold, Platinum and Elite membership tiers. Accumulated points can be redeemed for free slot play, merchandise in the gift shop, Kids Quest® hourly child care, and any of the casino's six restaurants. Players will automatically achieve Gold status with enrollment in the Red Hawk Rewards Club. To achieve Platinum status, players must accumulate 60,000 points in a six-month period, including January – June and July – December. For Elite status, which also provides access to express line passes, local hotel discounts, two complimentary buffets daily, and a VIP phone line, players must accumulate 150,000 points in a six-month period, including January – June and July – December.

- **Bars:** Red Hawk Casino features four entertainment bars including Mahogany Bar, located in Henry's Steakhouse, which is an elegant bar serving local wines and specialty spirits in an intimate atmosphere. Other bars include the Stage Bar which presents live entertainment on a nightly basis by regional performers; a sports bar where fans can catch all the games; and the High-Limit Bar for high-rollers. Complimentary non-alcoholic beverages are available on the main casino floor. Alcoholic beverages are also available at pricing similar to other area bars and restaurants.
- **Gift Shop:** Red Hawk Traders is the official gift shop for Red Hawk Casino. It features apparel with the Red Hawk Casino logo including hats, t-shirts and sweatshirts, jewelry and artwork. Basic sundries including snacks, candy and books are also available.
- **Childcare:** Kids Quest® is located on level seven. The children's entertainment facilities feature supervised, hourly care services for children six weeks to 12 years-old. Cyber Quest is a non-supervised arcade perfect for kids of all ages. It features state-of-the-art technology and all the latest non-violent games.
- **Parking:** Parking at Red Hawk Casino is free for casino guests. Visitors can opt for complimentary valet parking or can choose to park in the multi-level parking garage, which features more than 3,000 lighted and covered parking spaces.

## Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians

### History of the Shingle Springs Band

The Miwok and Maidu people lived peacefully along the Sierra Nevada Mountains and throughout the Sacramento region for thousands of years. The arrival of the Gold Rush era in 1849 brought with it many miners who staked claim to the Band's original home at Discovery Park, forcing the people to disperse throughout Sacramento and beyond. By the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, the U.S. Department of the Interior established what is now the Shingle Springs Rancheria for the remaining people. A federally-recognized Tribal Nation since its establishment on March 11, 1920, the Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians are stewards of the land who continue to preserve their culture and traditions, in honor of those who came before them and for the benefit of future generations.

### The Shingle Springs Rancheria

The Shingle Springs Rancheria is located just off of U.S. Highway 50 in El Dorado County, Calif. Today, the 160-acre Rancheria is home to the Band's Tribal Government and Administration offices, 23 private residences, Tribal health clinic, Tribal library, community center, fire station, a state-of-the-art waste water treatment and disposal facility, and Red Hawk Casino. Since the mid-1990s, the Rancheria's Tribal health clinic was the only Medi-Cal provider in El Dorado County, serving 30 percent Native and 70 percent non-Native patients. In 2005, the Tribal clinic became one of two medical clinics to provide Medi-Cal services to county residents. Separately, in 2008, the Rancheria negotiated an agreement with the El Dorado Irrigation District to procure water delivery for commercial use, an opportunity that was previously limited to only 40 residences as a result of restrictions placed on the Rancheria in 1988 by the El Dorado County Local Agency Formation Commission.

### Access to the Rancheria

Since 1965, access to the Shingle Springs Rancheria has been severely restricted following the realignment of U.S. Highway 50. This realignment limited access to the Rancheria to a single, winding, rural road. Since 1997, this road has been strictly controlled by surrounding homeowners, limiting commercial access which severely impacted the Band's ability to bring economic opportunities to its people. After decades of litigation, and working with state and county officials, the Band finally won the right to build a highway interchange, enabling it to gain unencumbered commercial access to its Rancheria. Construction began on the Red Hawk Parkway interchange in June 2007. Completed in November 2008, the Red Hawk Parkway interchange was 100 percent funded by the Shingle Springs Band at no cost to the taxpayers of El Dorado County, and was the first of many steps taken by the Band in its ongoing pursuit of self-reliance.

### Giving Back to the Community

Per its Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with El Dorado County, the Shingle Springs Band will provide more than \$190 million to El Dorado County to use at its own discretion over the next 20 years. Additionally, the Band has committed annual contributions to the county in the amounts of \$500,000 for law enforcement and up to \$500,000 from a pass-through of sales taxes collected on retail goods. The Band will also provide \$104 million to the county to extend the HOV carpool lanes on Highway 50.
